It started back in September when we were blessed with perfect weather for our annual Hog Roast where we gave each child a re-usable water bottle as we supported the quest to reduce the use of single use plastics.

A record number of tickets were sold for our Fireworks display as the school community came together once again for a terrific evening. With nearly 400 tickets sold and the rain holding off it was a superb event; raising £1,334.75 towards the committees 2019/20 focus.



Together with the dedication of the Bacon Butties volunteers, who are there for our Friday breakfasts come rain or shine, the bespoke Christmas Cards, the Christmas decoration workshop, the event raffles (donated and arranged by parents) and of course the ever popular cake sales, we do, as a community make a difference for our children.
