





TAKASHI MURAKAMI





Takashi Murakami is a Japanese contemporary artist. He works in fine arts media as well as commercial media and is known for his colourful, vibrant floral patterns.






*David Hockney is a British painter, draftsman, printmaker, stage designer, and photographer. As an important contributor to the pop art movement of the 1960s, he is considered one of the most influential British artists of the 20th century. **Born:** 9 July 1937 (age 82 years)*

Using varying numbers of Polaroid snaps or photo lab prints of a single subject, Hockney arranged a patchwork to create a new image. Because these photographs are taken from different perspectives and at slightly different times, the result is work that has an affinity with Cubism. They have a real sense of movement and life about them.

BANKSY IS AN ANONYMOUS ENGLAND-BASED STREET ARTIST, VANDAL, POLITICAL ACTIVIST, AND FILM DIRECTOR, ACTIVE SINCE THE 1990S. HIS SATIRICAL STREET ART AND SUBVERSIVE EPIGRAMS COMBINE DARK HUMOUR WITH GRAFFITI EXECUTED IN A DISTINCTIVE STENCILING TECHNIQUE.



What is installation art?

THE TERM 'INSTALLATION ART' IS USED TO DESCRIBE LARGE-SCALE, MIXED-MEDIA CONSTRUCTIONS, OFTEN DESIGNED FOR A SPECIFIC PLACE OR FOR A TEMPORARY PERIOD OF TIME. THIS IS A TYPE OF ARTWORK THAT VIEWERS CAN SOMETIMES WALK THROUGH, THAT CAN ENGAGE ALL OF YOUR SENSES (SOUND, SMELL, TASTE, VISION, TOUCH).

OLAFUR ELIASSON

Olafur Eliasson is a Danish-Icelandic artist known for sculptures and large-scale installation art employing elemental materials such as light, water, and air temperature to enhance the viewer's experience.

The Weather Project, represents the sun and the sky. An artificially generated mist permeates the space, as if creeping in from the environment outside. This is accompanied by a giant semi-circular form made up of hundreds of mono-frequency lamps.

How does this artificially generated sun promote a sense of community?


YAYOI KUSAMA IS A JAPANESE CONTEMPORARY ARTIST WHO WORKS PRIMARILY IN SCULPTURE AND INSTALLATION, BUT IS ALSO ACTIVE IN PAINTING, PERFORMANCE, FILM, FASHION, POETRY, FICTION, AND OTHER ARTS.

THE OBLITERATION ROOM IS A LARGE SCALE INSTALLATION THAT STARTED OFF COMPLETELY WHITE. VIEWERS WERE THEN ALLOWED TO COVER THE ROOM IN COLOURFUL SPOTTY STICKERS.

WHAT DOES ABSTRACT MEAN?

Abstract art uses a visual language of shape, form, colour and line to create a composition which may exist with a degree of independence from visual references in the world.

Western art had been, from the Renaissance up to the mid 19th century, underpinned by the logic of perspective and an attempt to reproduce an illusion of visible reality.

By the end of the 19th century many artists felt a need to create a new kind of art which would encompass the fundamental changes taking place in technology, science and philosophy.


Abstraction indicates a departure from reality in depiction of imagery in art. This departure from accurate representation can be slight, partial, or complete. Abstraction exists along a continuum.


