
Getting Logged-in




Go to www.google.com in your web browser.

In the top right corner, click 'sign in'.

You will be prompted to login - please use your child's Barrow Hills email address and password. You should only need to do this once unless there are multiple google users.





Accessing Google Classroom



Click on the cluster of nine dots. This opens up the menu.


Click on classroom.

When you have logged in, you will land on the homepage, which shows your child's subject classes:



Assignments that have been posted by teachers will appear underneath the subject classroom.

This allows you to see which assignments are current.



When you click on the subject classroom, you will land on the 'stream'.

All assignments that are set by teachers will appear on the stream and can be accessed from this page

You can access both current and previous assignments by clicking on 'classwork' at the top of the page.

Time Graphs - Extension Task

Here are 4 sets of data. Each set of data has been plotted onto a graph, but the graphs have been lost. Your task is to describe what the graphs will look like. I have started off the first one for you:


- 1) A walk in the countryside:

Time taken (hrs)	0	$\frac{1}{2}$	1	$1\frac{1}{2}$	2	$2\frac{1}{2}$	3	$3\frac{1}{2}$	4	$4\frac{1}{2}$	5	$5\frac{1}{2}$
Distance (km)	0	2	3	4	4	4	7	7	8	9	10	10

The graph goes up from 0 hours to $1\frac{1}{2}$ hours. At $1\frac{1}{2}$ hours it is flat at 4km until $2\frac{1}{2}$ hours. Between $2\frac{1}{2}$ hours and 3 hours it goes up. Then at 3 hours.....
- 2) The temperature through the day:

Time	7am	8am	9am	10am	11am	12pm	1pm	2pm	3pm	4pm	5pm	6pm	7pm
Temperature	2°C	3°C	5°C	7°C	10°C	17°C	22°C	25°C	25°C	21°C	16°C	13°C	9°C



When your child has either completed their work online, or has uploaded their work or a photo of it, please click 'Hand in' to send the work to the teacher.





There is also an option to add a 'private comment' here - this can be used by you or your child to communicate directly with the teacher at any stage in the assignment.

Navigating the Classroom



Wherever you are in Google Classroom, you can get to another class by clicking on the three lines here.

A handy feature to keep track of your work


There is a 'To-do' list feature, which you can access here:

Accessing a Form Time Google Meet

In the Stream in the Form Time classroom, you will see a 'Meet link'



Clicking on this will link through to the form time in the Google Meet app. Your child may need to log-in the first time you access this.

The Google Meet is only accessible **when the teacher is in the meeting**. So please follow the timings from the teacher for when the live form time will start.
